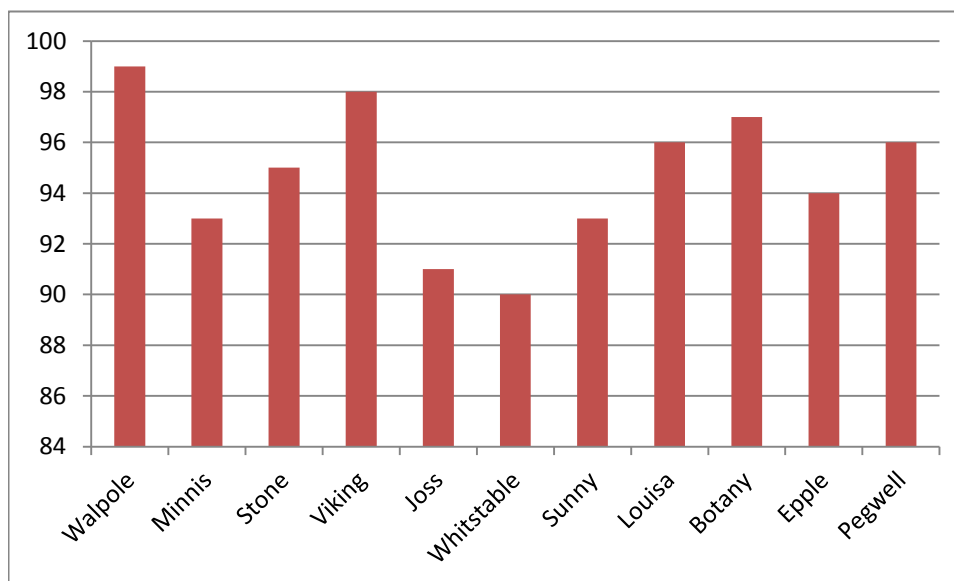
Dear Parents and Carers
